Shanghai summers are hot and humid, while winters are damp and chilly, so you'll need season-appropriate clothing!

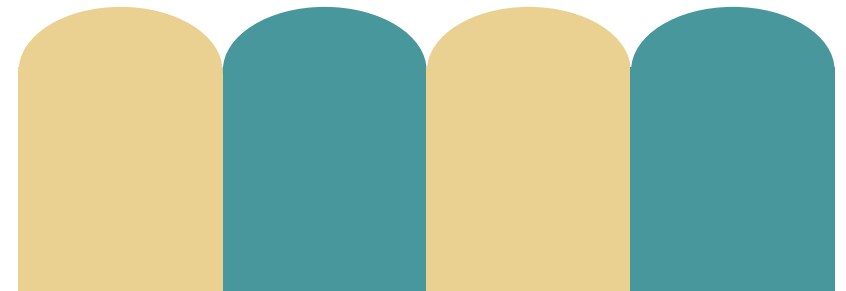













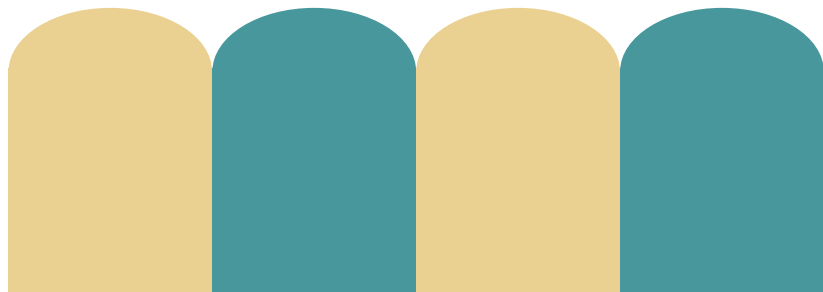
## Two Passport Photos

Please bring 2 passport photos. This is for student ID, and your student profile. If you don't have it, no worries, life advisor can take you to the photo-taking shop here near the school after you arrive.



## Common Medications

You can bring some basic medications, such as cold medicine or medicine for diarrhea, just in case. Of course, you can also buy them at local pharmacies after you arrive in Shanghai.





## Official Documents

Please bring your passport with a valid Chinese visa. Citizens of the following countries and territories will be able to enjoy a 30-day visa-free stay in China:

Europe (34 countries): France, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands, Spain, Switzerland, Ireland, Hungary, Austria, Belgium, Luxembourg, Poland, Slovenia, Portugal, Greece, Cyprus, Slovakia, Norway, Finland, Denmark, Iceland, Andorra, Monaco, Liechtenstein, Bulgaria, Romania, Croatia, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Malta, Estonia, Latvia, Russia, Sweden, the United Kingdom

Oceania (2 countries): Australia, New Zealand

Asia (9 countries): Brunei, South Korea, Japan, Saudi Arabia, Oman, Kuwait, Bahrain, Singapore, Thailand

South America (5 countries): Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Peru, Uruguay

If the Chinese language program you take at Keats is longer than 4 weeks, we can send you the necessary documents to apply for a student visa that covers your entire stay at Keats.

# ARRIVAL

## Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG) T1 and T2

We will pick you up at the airport.

If you arrive at Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG) T1 on an international flight, we will wait for you outside the Exit 4 in the International Arrivals Hall with a KEATS pickup sign. If you are arriving on a domestic flight, we will wait for you at the Exit 2 in the Domestic Arrivals Hall with a KEATS pickup sign.

If you arrive at Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG) T2 on an international flight, we will wait for you outside the Gate 2A in the International Arrivals Hall with a KEATS pickup sign. If you are arriving on a domestic flight and you don't have checked bags, we will meet you at Gate 2C; if your bags are on carousel 35–39, we will still be at Gate 2C on Level 2, and if they are on carousel 40–45, we will wait for you at Gate 2D on Level B1, both times holding a KEATS pickup sign.



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# ARRIVAL

## Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport (SHA) T1 and T2

We will pick you up at the airport.

If you arrive at Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport (SHA) T1 on an international flight, we will wait for you at the International Arrivals area with a KEATS pickup sign. If you are arriving on a domestic flight, we will wait for you at the Domestic Arrivals Hall with a KEATS pickup sign.

If you arrive at Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport (SHA) T2 on a domestic flight and you have checked luggage, we will meet you on Floor 1; if you are traveling with carry-on only, we will meet you on Floor 2. On Floor 2, for carousels 28–33 we will wait at the South Rainbow Bridge exit, and for carousels 22–27 at the North Rainbow Bridge exit, both times holding a KEATS pickup sign.

If you don't see us, please do not walk away, and please do not walk to the outside of the airport. You can call us 86-130-99999-553 or add us on WeChat: 13099999553.

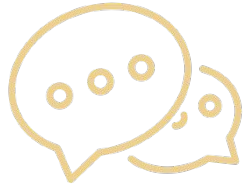


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## ATM Cash Withdraw

If you use a foreign credit card on a Chinese ATM, you can withdraw RMB cash with a limit of RMB 2000 per withdraw. Transaction fee might be high as it is done in a foreign country.

Please confirm with your bank or notice them that you will use your credit/debit card in China. Many students encountered problems when they withdrew money in Chengdu. Their bank blocked their cards because the bank suspected their cards were stolen.



## Shopping in China

Most stores in Shanghai do not use foreign credit cards for daily payments. More specifically, credit cards with “VISA” or “MASTER” are accepted mainly in large shopping malls and hotels, but they may not be accepted in many local stores. It is more convenient to use mobile payment methods when making purchases in Shanghai. Chinese people commonly use WeChat Pay or Alipay through mobile phones. You can also use WeChat Pay or Alipay by linking a valid card to your account.



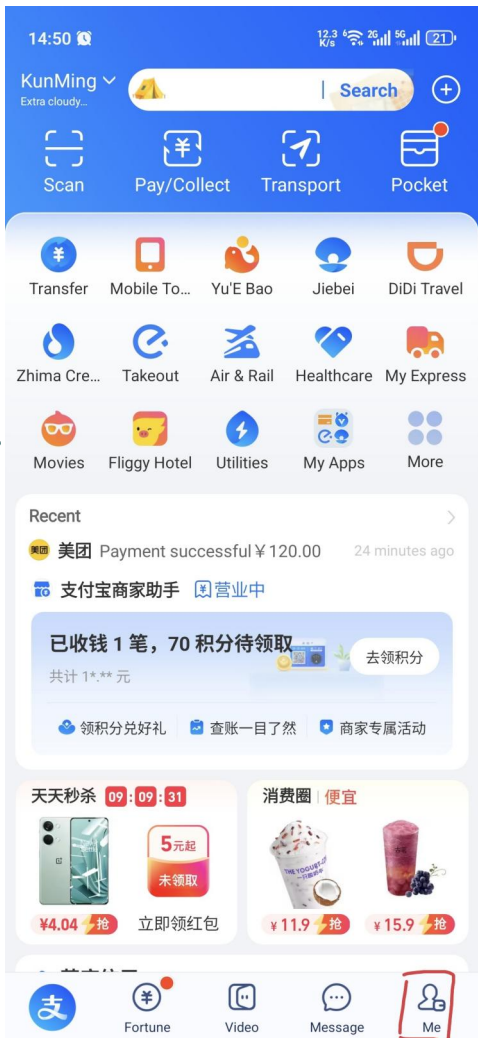
## How to use Alipay and Wechat

WeChat and Alipay now support foreign users to bind with visa or master and other foreign credit cards to use. However, there are certain restrictions on usage scenarios, the transactions can only be conducted with merchants that support or have foreign credit cards such as Visa and Master. Except for large supermarkets or shopping malls, many small stores or online stores on Taobao and Jingdong do not support payment with foreign currency credit cards.

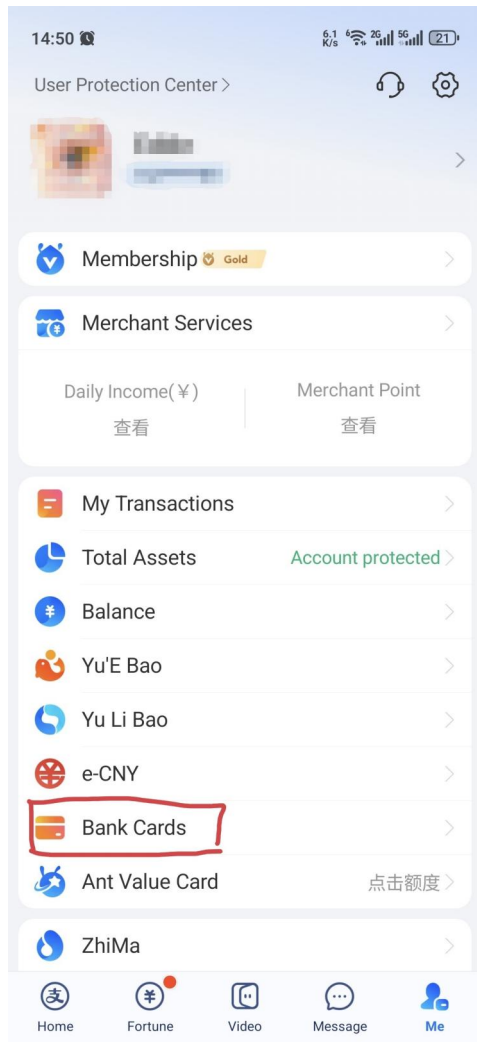

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# 01

Please check with your insurance provider that your insurance can cover the medical expense while you are abroad before you leave your country. Many Chinese insurance providers do not provide medical insurance for foreigners.



# 02

If you have a minor illness while you are at Keats, such as cold and cough, Keats School can provide you with medicine for free. If you need to see a doctor, the life advisor can take you to the hospital. Close to Keats School is Shanghai Changzheng Hospital.

If you need to purchase insurance in China, you can contact Keats for assistance. However, this insurance is only available to holders of the X2 student visa.

No vaccinations are needed, but we suggest all students consult with their doctor concerning personal needs or concerns.

## Subway

The closest metro station is Shanghai Museum of Natural History Metro Subway Station with line 13. It is so easy to get around.



## Taxi

The starting rate for a taxi in Shanghai is RMB 14 yuan (for the first 3 km). A ride within the inner ring usually costs RMB 25–60 yuan, but expect the meter to jump quickly in heavy traffic. Cabs are scarce during the morning and evening rush, so allow extra time or grab a metro instead.



## Shared Bikes

Shared bikes are now also a very common mode of transportation in China. Generally speaking, using shared bikes requires using WeChat and Alipay for payment.

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# Shanghai

## The Bund

*From School, you can walk about 650 meters to West Nanjing Road Station (Lines 2/12/13). Then take Metro Line 2 (toward Pudong International Airport) for 2 stops to East Nanjing Road Station. From Exit 3, walk about 800 meters east along Nanjing Road to reach The Bund. It takes 30 minutes to get there.*

# Shanghai

## Oriental Pearl Tower

From the school, you can walk about 650 meters to West Nanjing Road Station (Line 2). Next, take Metro Line 2 (toward Pudong International Airport) for 3 stops to Lujiazui Station. After exiting from Exit 2, walk about 400 meters to reach the Oriental Pearl Tower. It takes 30 minutes to get there.

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# Shanghai

## Yuyuan Garden

From the school, you can walk about 650 meters to West Nanjing Road Station (Line 2). Take Metro Line 2 (toward Pudong International Airport) for 2 stops to East Nanjing Road Station, and then transfer to Metro Line 10 for 1 stop to Yuyuan Garden Station. From Exit 1, walk about 300-400 meters to reach Yu Garden. It takes 40 minutes to get there.

# Shanghai

## Nanjing Road Pedestrian Street

From the school, you can walk about 650 meters to West Nanjing Road Station (Line 2). Take Metro Line 2 (toward Pudong International Airport) for 2 stops to East Nanjing Road Station. From Exit 3, walk about 200 meters to reach Nanjing Road Pedestrian Street. It takes 20 minutes to get there.

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# Shanghai

## Xintiandi

From the school, you walk about 600 meters to Shanghai Natural History Museum Station (Line 13). Then take Metro Line 13 (toward Zhangjiang Road) for 3 stops to Xintiandi Station.

From Exit 2, walk about 500 meters to reach Xintiandi. It takes 30 minutes to get there.

# Shanghai

## Tianzifang

From the school, you can walk about 500 meters to Shanghai Natural History Museum Station (Line 13). Then take Metro Line 13 (toward Zhangjiang Road) for 4 stops to Madang Road Station. From Exit 4, walk about 730 meters to reach Tianzifang. It takes 30 minutes to get there.





# Shanghai

## Qibao Ancient Town

From the school, you can walk about 900 meters to West Nanjing Road Station (Line 12). Take Metro Line 12 (toward Qixin Road) for 2 stops to Jiashan Road Station, which is the official interchange between Lines 12 and 9. Then transfer to Metro Line 9 (toward Songjiang South Railway Station) for 8 stops to Qibao Station. Exit from Exit 4 and walk about 900 meters to reach Qibao Ancient Town. It takes nearly 1 hour to get there.

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# Shanghai

## Shanghai Museum

From the school, you can walk about 650 meters to West Nanjing Road Station (Line 2). Take Metro Line 2 (toward Pudong International Airport) for 6 stops to Shanghai Science and Technology Museum Station. From Exit 3, walk about 800 meters to reach Shanghai Museum. It takes 40 minutes to get there.

# Shanghai

## China Art Museum

From the school, you can walk about 650 meters to West Nanjing Road Station (Line 2). Take Metro Line 2 for 1 stop to People's Square Station, then transfer to Metro Line 8 (toward Shendu Highway) for 5 stops to China Art Museum Station. From Exit 3, walk about 200 meters to reach the museum. It takes 40 minutes to get there.

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# Shanghai

## Shanghai Disney Resort

From the school, you can walk about 650 meters to Metro Line 2 at Nanjing West Road Station (toward Panxiang Road) for 2 stops to Jiangsu Road Station. Then transfer to Line 11 toward Disney Resort; ride 16 stops to Disney Resort Station. From Exit 1, walk about 600 meters to reach the entrance. It takes 1 hour and 20 minutes to get there.

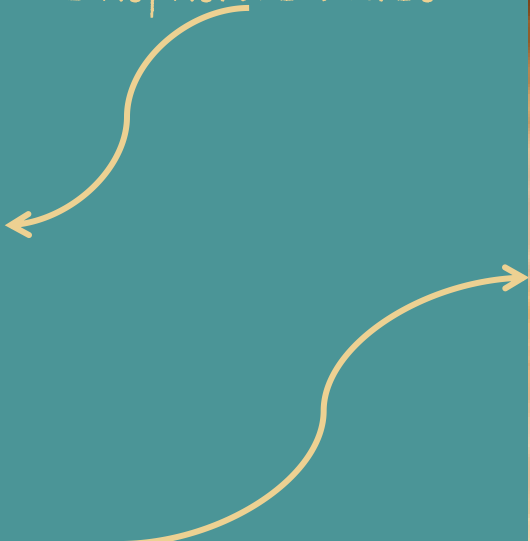

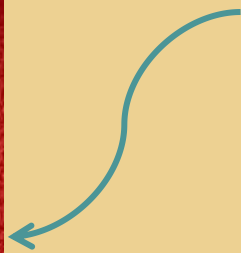

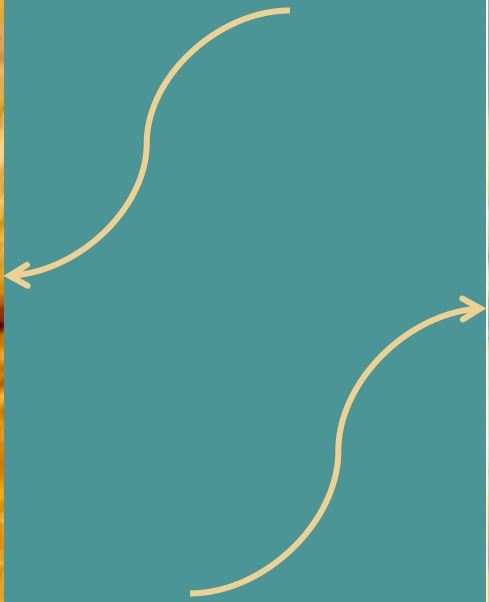
